Things to Remember



Personal Protection, Your Safety First!

- Time, Distance, Shielding
- Stay Uphill & Upwind of any fire, smoke, cloud
- Be aware of your surroundings & exits
- If something seems odd...
- Know where to get accurate information

Reporting Emergencies:

- ☞ Know your location - Are you safe?
- ☞ What is the emergency?
 - Motor vehicle accident
 - Fire
 - Flooded roadway
 - Disabled vehicle
 - Debris in roadway, etc...
- ☞ Use 9-1-1 to report emergency
 - Use County Radio if unable to phone in
- ☞ Be Calm, identify yourself
 - Provide specific information

Crime Prevention

- Don't make yourself a target
- Know your neighborhood
- Report suspicious activity & conditions
- Watch out for your neighbors

Describing people:

- ◇ Sex
- ◇ People
- ◇ Height
- ◇ Age
- ◇ Build
- ◇ Weight
- ◇ Clothing



Describing vehicles:

- ◇ Color, body style, size
- ◇ Make, model, year
- ◇ License plate, state, number, color
- ◇ Distinguishing features:
 - Damage
 - Tinted windows
 - Writing or symbols
 - Luggage/bicycle racks etc...
